BUKIT, BALI



If you have any doubts about the friendliness of the Balinese people: Smile at them and you will see how welcoming they are !




4. Surf's up

The Do's -

- Baik = I'm fine

Air Conditioning



Air Conditioning is available in every bedroom. Please remember to turn off the AC when leaving and ensure that all doors and windows are closed while it's running. Together, we can reduce our negative impact on the environment.

Smart TV

The villa is equipped with flat screen TV's, with the option to connect your personal Netflix account. If you were to encounter any difficulties, please ask our staff assist you.



Safety Box



To keep your valuable items safe, we provide a safety box. Please note. that we can't be responsible for stolen or lost belongings in the villa.



We provide laundry services through a third party. Please ask the staff for assistance. It usually takes up to 24 to 48 hours, and the price will be calculated per piece.



Please respect your neighbours. We ask that you keep the noise at a reasonable level, especially when listening to music, or when leaving the villa. Everyone in the district is asked to lower the volume after 10pm, as the local authorities do not accept events or parties after this time. Note for those interested in the nightlife: There are plenty of clubs and bars in the main street just steps away. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding.



The cleaning staff comes to the villa from 9 am to 5 pm every day unless you request for more privacy. Bed sheets and towels will be changed every third day. All the linen and towels shall remain in the property



at all times.

Smoking is strictly prohibited indoors. Please use the outside areas for smoking. Ashtrays are available.



As we are 8 degree south of the equator, heavy tropical rain can happen. Garden can seem flooded pretty fast. But don't stress, it will dry quickly once the rain stops.

As a small island with limited natural resources, Bali is very fragile. We would like to protect Bali and keep it safe. To achieve this, we need your support and understanding to help protect the environment:

AC and lights off: please consider turning off the AC and lights when you are not using the space. AC will cool down the room within 15 minutes.
We provide a water dispenser with drinkable water in the kitchen for you to use, and to help reduce the use of plastic on the island.

Note: The villa is equipped with a special water filtration system to deliver the best quality of water possible. However, we do not recommend drinking water from the tap.

Transportation




